The Parasol Midge fly pattern may look weird but it works. It is best fished when it is calm, no wind, during mornings when trout tend to feed on buzzers and keen on emerging midge. The fly is tied so that the emerging midge pupae is suspended just below the water surface.

GRIFFITH'S GNAT

GRIFFITH'S GNAT

Griffith's Gnat is a popular fly pattern used by fly fishermen around the world. It was created by Craig Mathews, a fly fishing guide and owner of Blue Ribbon Flies in West Yellowstone, Montana, in honor of his friend George Griffith, who loved to fish the Madison River in Montana.

The fly pattern imitates a small midge or mosquito, and is typically tied on a size 18-22 hook. The body of the fly is made from a small amount of black dubbing, and the wings are made from a few strands of white or cream-colored hackle tips. A tiny tuft of white poly yarn is often added at the head of the fly to help the angler see it on the water.
